- 10. <u>Fire department</u>: Nova-Working with Mars Company buying equipment, gloves, glasses, vests etc. Ordered all new helmets, 4 new sets of gear, looking into safety rain gear as well as other needed equipment. Still need to order brackets for CBC, also looking into a new compressor system. Rescue rig all settled. Some fire departments working on a plan to get their first responders to cover for others. All unnecessary FD equipment is sold at the moment, they are still looking for an AVT trailer.

Bought new tires for the brusher, there is a brusher tractor for sale on the website looks to be in good shape, accepting bids until 2/14, board will look on website. Trying to keep the roads drivable but the weather has not been cooperating. Hydraulics still not working on the backhoe, but Deere says it is fixed. All keys still need to be collected for the hall for ex-employees, the door in the shop is being left open.
