Regular Board Meeting July 13, 2023.

- 1. Meeting: Called to order by Chairman Scott Luostari at 6:31 pm.

- 3.County Board: Scott-Tomorrow zoning Camp Amnicon ordinance to come up. County Board to dig more in depth on the campground ordinance issues. Land development is on the 25<sup>th</sup>, the committees will be back to full schedules come August. Transportation meeting-ATV/UTV ordinance reviewed and looked at all trails. There were 17 ATV/UTV crashes last year, 1/2 were alcohol and drug related, as well as 58 citations. There are around 330,000 registered ATVs and 150,000 UTV's. 7/5 Transportation Committee-Highway 13 is in progress, Highway H has 50% of the design phase completed. No seasonal workers on the County highway department, Highway department is 7 full time positions short, including 1 foreman. County and State are starting to mow. County Board appointed their 2 new members. The County had 1.02 million in timber sales, and they have 4 million towards the Blatnik Bridge reconstruction project.
- 4.Town Board Report: Mary said Middle River Road looked good. There were multiple complaints of fireworks on Middle River Road over the holiday.

- B) McMahon-wants to put in 3 campsites, owners from the cities. Because there are only 3 properties they do not need to be vacated at this time. But the fine print on the application says, "pending Towns vacating approval." Campground ordinance progress slowed down after Tessa left. Still moving forward, legal also reviewing-most issues will be with property setbacks,

sanitary, size of out buildings, and whether existing campgrounds need to be brought up to these standards or grandfathered in. The one on 13 was sold, and now it needed to be brought up to current standards.

Public-Camp Amnicon Road-Lots of big RVs are going down that road already, road barely has enough gravel etc. to handle the traffic now. Unsupervised camping can create noise, garbage, and other issues. People from all over are trespassing on anyone's land. Advertising on the website for up to 16 people per site. Could potentially increase theft and destruction of the area. It was suggested the board go at look at things themselves before deciding. Mary made a motion to hold off until the board gets a chance to look at the sites, Gerald seconded, date to be determined later, carried 7:16 pm. If passed it would not be grandfathered in for the new ordinance. Also, the road gets really bad in the spring, campers would get struck and tear up the road.
